She recently completed her Bachelor of Music Performance with Honours at the University of Melbourne, studying with Mardi McCusker. Tamara has performed with the Australian Youth Orchestra, Melbourne Youth Orchestra and Sydney Youth Orchestra. She has also performed as a soloist with the Sydney Youth Philharmonic Orchestra, Kuringai Philharmonic Orchestra and Melbourne University String Ensemble. Tamara has also toured extensively throughout Australia and internationally with Co Opera.

Tamara has been a chosen finalist in the Hepzibah Menuhin Performance Award. She is an active chamber musician who has performed in various collaborations with Victorian Opera and also the National Gallery of Victoria.

In 2013, she travelled to the prestigious Banff Centre in Canada, studying with Tara O'Connor and Ransom Wilson. Tamara has recently returned from a three-month study tour throughout Europe, as a Skills and Development grant awardee from the Australia Council for the Arts.
